## **MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT**

I would like to thank all supporters that travelled and/or showed up each week to get behind us, and a special thank you to all past players that have attended, and ensured the Westies spirit lives on. Particular mention to Ken Norris and Dave Thornton for making an appearance and giving the lads an inspirational speech prior to the Grand Finals we took part in, truly appreciated. Everyone was surprised to learn that a keen eye is still kept on the side's performance. It is awesome to know.

A big thank you must also go out to all the behind the scenes assistance. John Condon to score week in week out, to Marty Polhill for helping with lunches, and generally just buzzing around, Thanks! Gus Polhill – Taking his first 5 wicket haul for the club. 5/41 (10) Vs Weston Creek  
Dale Riley – Taking 4 five wicket hauls through the season, including 6/22 (10) against Eastlake.

Darren Richards – 123\* against Norths, His 10<sup>th</sup> Century for the Club.

Matt Condon – Scoring his first century for Wests first grade. 104 vs Weston Creek, becoming the 5<sup>th</sup> youngest player to ton up in ACT first grade cricket history. Also scoring 94 and sharing a match winning 172 run Partnership with Adam Hewitt in the Grand Final against Tuggeranong.

Ethan Bartlett – Scoring his first century for the club. 107\* Vs ANU. Also took his first 5 wicket haul taking 7/41 (17) against Tuggeranong in the Grand Final earning him the Greg Irvine Medal.

Adam Hewitt – Scoring his first 150 for the club. 154\* against Tuggeranong in the Grand Final narrowly missing out on the Greg Irvine Medal. Also scored 95 against Tuggeranong previously and averaged over 280 against them across the season.

Beau McClintock - representing ACT Comets and ACT under 19's in the National Titles earning Australian under 19's Honour squad selection.

Matt Condon and Nic Skelly – Both represented ACT under 17's in the National titles, both making centuries during the tournament.

We had 4 players make their Debut for first grade this season, and by rights earn their number on their baggy cap.

2012 – 2013

During my time at WDUCCC, West's 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade has celebrated only moderate success. Strong one year, weaker the next, a trait typical of a team where selections and availabilities impact heavily on the consistency of performances. 2012-2013 presented a host of challenges for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade side. The focus for the season was to show greater application across all facets of our game.

The season promised to be a huge challenge for myself, the first time I had captained a cricket side in an ongoing basis. The challenge was set to the players, the onus placed upon them to become better cricketers, show more application, be more consistent, play hard and put real pressure on the 1<sup>st</sup> Graders to perform to hold their spots.

The season commenced in what can only be described as diabolical conditions against ANU. Persistent rain forced the wash out of every game in the ACTCA that weekend, all except ours. And it was far from a spectacle. Bowled out within 30 overs for a meagre 109, and limited with bowling options due to the wet conditions, the side fought hard and were successful, taking a Duckworth/Lewis result by somewhere between 8 and 15 runs. Better things were to come.

In my absence, old stager, David Roberts captained the boys in the majority of the T20 competition. Whilst performing solidly in this competition, winning half our games, we missed finals on net run rate, after a heavy loss to Tuggeranong, a match that was rescheduled (due to the untimely and unfortunate passing of Glenn Thornton). While some clubs made rescheduling of these postponed games difficult for TVCC, WDUCCC accommodated the request, this action much appreciated by Tuggeranong.

The One Day competition started well for us, a win v ANU and a washout against Weston Creek took us through to the start of the Two Day competition. Upon recommencement of the One Day competition, we encountered three of the stronger teams in quick succession, and were duly put back in our place. Losses to Queanbeyan and Tuggeranong in back to back games, followed by a narrow and controversial loss to Eastlake in the match before Christmas saw our chances in the One Day competitions almost fade away.

After Christmas, we came up against Ginninderra, and, with a 'lightning' affected conclusion, we took the points, with a bonus point win. The following week, against North's, and with our style of cricket starting to come together, we posted a total of note, 6/315. Substantial contributions through the order, none more impressive than 76 off 42 balls by Karl Vendrascio. North's were up against it, and we duly dealt with them, dismissing them for 122.

The win over North's saw us take the last finals spot from them, and matched us against Weston Creek in the Semi Final. A comfortable win in the end, saw us progress to a home Grand Final against Queanbeyan. The Grand Final was a nail biter, an important partnership in the chase, between Karl Vendrascio and Alex Taylor

saw us go from a precarious position, to within sight of the result. Blake Moore, on a flat and low wicket, showed plenty of courage to go over the top for consecutive boundaries, securing WDUCCC the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade One Day trophy.

The Two Day competition started slowly for us, a first innings loss to North's in the first round really hurt, and the side galvanised to deliver two comprehensive outright wins in our next two games, over Ginninderra and ANU. The win against Ginninderra saw us chase a small total. Not impressive on its own, however, we were only left 21 minutes to achieve the target. David Spare and Peter McKell played with power and conviction and we were successful in the chase, with more than 5 minutes to spare.

At the Christmas break, we were in first place, a lead that we did not relinquish through the remaining matches. Our only loss in that period was to Queanbeyan, however we had done enough to secure the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Minor Premiership.

The Semi Final against Tuggeranong saw us lead with the ball, as we had done so well through the year in this format. Bowling them out for 159, Pete McKell was the destroyer with another 5 wicket haul. We secured first innings before lunch on the second day, again, Alex Taylor and Karl Vendrasco part of the partnership that reeled in the deficit and enable us to take a lead. Contributions through the middle and lower order saw our innings close on 336. Tuggeranong came hard in the second innings to try and address the deficit, but good bowling from Ben Willis saw Tuggeranong call an end to their season at stumps on day 2, still 70 runs behind and with only 3 wickets remaining.

Through to the Grand Final, and a rematch with Queanbeyan. Overnight rain and a very wet pair of batting boxes on the square, saw both teams agree to try and commence play as soon as possible, with leaf blowers and industrial heaters sought out to dry the wicket. Queanbeyan won the toss and bowled in overcast conditions. The swinging ball presented our batsmen with substantial difficulty, and we ended the days play nine down, with not enough runs. Bright sunshine greeted us the following morning, and while we didn't add significantly to our overnight score, we thought we had a total we could defend. And we almost did, Queanbeyan passed out total with only 2 wickets in hand, but once they did, they built quickly on their lead, and the final two partnerships allowed Queanbeyan to wrestle the game into their control. The 113 run lead was significant; however, we went out with an attacking mindset and set about reducing the deficit. Reaching 82 by stumps, the lead was within sight; however we had lost 6 wickets. The following morning, Alex Taylor and Ben Willis lead the charge and with an 82 run lead, a faint glimmer of hope was still there. We took three wickets on our way, however Queanbeyan were too good for us and passed out total just after 2pm.

While it was a disappointing way to end the season, looking at the goals we had set at the start of the season, we can be pleased with how and where 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade finished the season.

David Spare, Karl Vendrasco, Nick Polhill, Alex Taylor all scored over 400 runs. There were 23 half centuries by players in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Unfortunately, no hundreds for 2's this season, so we all know there is still much improvement ahead.



There were 7 players with 17 or more wickets through the season. Ben Willis (36 wickets) and Peter McKell (31 wickets) were the only two players to take 5 wicket hauls, with both achieving this feat twice.

I also want to make mention of three young men, who, at their tender ages, performed admirably for the 2<sup>s</sup> this year. Nick and Lachlan Skelly and Blake MacDonald are three young men who have the potential to represent the club and beyond for many years to come. Nick played a significant contribution to first grade, Lachlan to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and Blake, over school holidays from Radford, was an important contributor to 2's this season.

It would be remiss of me, in a Captains Report, to not thank the network of individuals who enable the club to function. Jeff Clark as president and chairman of selectors, Bob Taylor as an everywhere man, Alex Taylor for his help with equipment and at training, club coach Ben Willis for all his efforts (training and game days), Ajay Mehta, Ben Oakley, Darren Richards, Troy Skelly, John Condon, Syed Jaffry, Suman Natarajan, Baden West, Jimmy Harrison and Alisa Clark (and her entire women's team), Jordan Smith, Pete McKell, Brendan Duffy, Bill McKell and the rest of the WDUCCC committee. As volunteers, we are very fortunate as players/members to have people willing to help us out, volunteering for sporting organisation is often a thankless task, very time consuming and at times difficult. I appreciate the efforts of all those mentioned, and for those who I have forgotten, my apologies, your thanks are also essential to the ongoing operations of the club.

I look forward to the next season and further success for the club.
