Your contribution to assist in making the Club work harmoniously and efficiently is encouraged.

WESTERN DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2003 – 2004

In reviewing the year 2003/04 it would be remiss not to mention the work of the immediate Past President, Gerard Garrity, A.S.M. Gerry took a lot of time and trouble to ensure that at the AGM in July 2003 there would be a full and able compliment of people to take on the various tasks associated with the smooth and efficient running of our Club.

When the AGM took place some of those that had indicated that they were prepared to take on various tasks found, that for a number of reasons they were unable to fulfil their intentions.

At the first meeting of the Management Committee, Alan Copland announced that as his job was now taking him to Sydney he was unable to continue as Secretary .The club was fortunate in that Ben Keens, already on the Committee, agreed to take on this onerous task, one that he has fulfilled admirably.

A further resignation occurred in November, when Matthew Veitch, Director of Grounds, advised that he would have to resign from the committee due to full time study. Once again the club was fortunate to have an able and committed replacement in Daniel King.

Of the remaining members, Jeff Clark and Jon Fuller came from club stalwarts, Jeff doubling up as Senior Vice-President and Chairman of Selectors, the latter being one, if not the, hardest job in any sporting organisation. There are always those that are: angry, disappointed and," could do the job better". From my perspective I did not hear any complaints. This was either due to good management by Jeff and his co selectors or possibly any complaints were not brought to my attention. I should like to think that it was the former.

Jon Fuller also doubled up. He took on the responsibility of Director of Cricket together with sponsorship and fund raising. With his years as Captain and long time membership of the Club Jon was admirably suited to the Director of Cricket task

The sponsorship task was full of disappointment. Although producing a professional package and approaching several potential sponsors, we were unable to secure any.

Fundraising was also a disappointment. A number of raffles were scheduled but after the lack of support for the first two the remaining two were cancelled. More on this matter later.

The other director was Graeme Death. Graeme took on the task of Practice Coordinator. He could be seen at most practice sessions as well as at the majority of matches.

The last member of the team was the Treasurer, Paul Goddard. Apart from selector this is probably the next most difficult task in an organisation. Paul has been the typical treasure, arguing against the spending of monies that had not been budgeted for and reminding the committee that whilst the club has some reserves it is prudent to budget for the minor items and to keep the reserves for unforseen major items.

Whilst the accounts are dealt with by the Treasurer, in his report, there are a few matters that need to be brought to your attention.

The cost of running a cricket club is in the vicinity of \$42,000 per year. Income is derived from five major sources: subscriptions, grants, from WDRUC and ACTCA, sponsorship and fundraising.

The club has sought to keep subscriptions to a reasonable level and to schedule payments at various times throughout the season. Despite these arrangements there were a number of members that had to be reminded, on a number of occasions, to pay their subscriptions and indeed some did not.

In the matter of grants there were two. One from the ACTCA and one from WDRUC. At the beginning of the year there was disappointment that the grant from WDRUC was lower than the previous year. In October the management committee met with members of the board of the Western District Rugby Union club, together with the Manager, Andrew Patterson and was able to negotiate for an increase in the amount of the grant. The proviso was that we ensured an increase in the number of members patronising the club.

To encourage patronage a number of BBQ's were held on Saturday evenings, after the matches and it is pleasing to note that there were reasonable numbers attending most of these occasions.

Sponsorship, or the lack of, has already been mentioned. With regards to fundraising, a number of events took place during the year with the most successful being the raffling of an autographed bat at the Prime Minister's match. With only six people, including a visitor from England, a little over \$3000 was raised and I take this opportunity to thank Jeff Clark and the few members who assisted. The total could have been more if there were more volunteers to assist in the selling of tickets.

The raffles, organised by Jon Fuller, met a similar fate, with some members selling more than their allocation of tickets whilst others sold very few, some as little as one ticket.

In order for the club to be able to meet its financial obligations in areas such as; affiliation fees to the ACTCA, umpires expenses, ground hire, insurance, curating, coaching, ball costs, equipment, repairs and maintenance as well as administrative costs, there needs to be a change in the club culture. There needs to be greater commitment to supporting the various fundraising activities, in the payment of subscriptions, in volunteering to assist in any other activities undertaken to promote the club and cricket in our area. If this commitment is not forthcoming members can expect to see a substantial increase in their subscriptions for 2004/2005.

At the beginning of the season the Club was unable to have the use of Jamison Oval. There were a number of reasons, not the least of which was the holding of the Master's Games. This was followed by some celebrations due to the Rugby World Cup. It was not until late November, after some hard work by our curator, Mark Hatton, that cricket was eventually played on the oval.

The outlook for 2004/2005 is looking promising, following discussion with Andrew Paterson, manager of WDRUC. It is hoped that 2nd and possibly 1st Grade will be played at Jamison in the early part of the season.

Despite the rather poor playing facilities that the Club had to endure there were some successes. Congratulations to Jimmy Harrison and his players for tying with North Canberra Gungahlin for the second grade One-Day Competition.

Congratulations to Ben Keens and the boys in fourth Grade for their resounding win against Ginninderra West Belconnen.

This has been only my second year with involvement with Club cricket and although I have spent some 40 years on committees in a number of countries around the world and in several diverse organisations it has been quite a challenge. There are several people that I need to thank for their help and contribution.

To all those that have served on the Management Committee thank you.

To Darryle McDonald, Club Coach. Thank you, not only for your work as coach but also for some timely advice on a range of matters.

To Marcus Cosgrave. Thank you for your advice and for listening to some of my longwinded telephone calls.

To the WDRUC and to Andrew Paterson in particular, thank you for your support and help during the year.

Finally, to you, the Member of the Western District Cricket Club. Thank you for allowing me the privilege of being your President.

I wish the incoming Committee all the best for the 2004/2005 season.

In particular, Gerard King and Mark Vergano provided our club with a lot of advice over the summer and they are congratulated for their efforts in helping make the grade competition a smooth and professional operation.

Of course, the club wouldn't be in its current financial position without the backing of our sponsors. The WDRUC was again a great supporter of our activities both financially and by providing us with the use of their facilities for functions and meetings. Our heartfelt thanks to Andrew and his staff for all of their assistance and goodwill.

Wests had a rebuilding year in 2003/04. Although we were more than competitive in all our games we always seemed to falter towards the end as if we had forgotten how to win.

The season did not begin as we had all hoped - we lost all our two day matches prior to Christmas. We did however manage two wins in the Konica Cup one day competition and set ourselves up to travel to Maitland for the finals of the Country Cup.

Season 2003-2004 was one of great satisfaction balanced by a copious dollop of dissatisfaction. We tied the un-tieable game in the 1-day final against Norths at Majura only to follow this up later in the year by being ignominiously bundled out of the 2-day finals loosing outright to Ginninderra in the last game of the year.

Following this debacle, the ACTCA kindly scheduled us for our 4th away game in a row at Sterling oval, where the nightmare of last seasons 9/531 declared by Weston Creek in the two day semi loomed large in our scarred minds. Although we again went down, it was an honorable defeat as the team as a whole dug in and showed some guts and determination. The inimitable Robert Maggs shone with the ball capturing 7/91 in Weston Creeks innings of 291 where he put on display his answer to Warneys "flipper" – the Maggs "flicker". Our top order bats took inspiration from the Maggsinator, and put together 263 in reply. Raj Singh (52) displayed some cavalier cricket and was ably supported by John Rogers (44) and Nathan Greatz (33).

Round 5 against Eastlake was a washout, but not before handsome Tim Purser compiled an equally handsome 61 batting at no.3. Onward to Round 6, where we were again trounced by ANU -179-, more than enough for our vegetarian reply of 145 all out. Contributors were Nick Jansen with 3/50 with the ball and Andrew Appledorf with a rear-guard 31 batting at 11.

Round 7 saw a fine one day result against Norths with Wests posting 173 on a typically difficult Kaleen wicket. Daniel Callaghan top scored with 69 and Andrew Appledorf once again stepped up making 31 batting at 10. In reply Norths could only muster 142 after being 5/104. The deciding factor was David Roberts who for the first 3 months of the season couldn't bat to save himself, so decided instead to take up bowling instead, knocking the final 5 Norths wickets over and finishing with 5/22 on the day. Where have they been hiding this round arm wonder?

Round 8 was a washout, and at the Christmas break we were 2 wins, 4 losses and 2 draws. Not exactly champagne cricket by any stretch of the imagination.

The holiday break regenerated our bodies and soul (except Robbo who abuses the first and has sold the second) and we returned to destroy Weston Creek in the Round 9 one-dayer at Phillip. They were bundled out for 71 by Jack Scasaghini (3/27) and Ben Allison (3/12 – playing his first game in 2nd grade), which we proceeded to knock off in 17 overs for the loss of 2 wickets.

The round 10 one-dayer against Eastlake at Kingston was a disappointment, given we notched up a highly defendable 233, with Jack Scasaghini wielding the blade on his way to a fine 88, including 2 memorable 6's, one of which was a mighty pull landing on the Pavillion square of the wicket. But, 233 wasn't quite enough with Eastlake getting them 9 down, Gerard King almost pulling us out of the mire with a last ditch 2/14 off 5 overs at the death.

A week later, knowing how much we loved playing away games, the ACTCA scheduled our second game against Queanbeyan for the season at Freebody for round 11. My what a lovely location and didn't little Lachy Funnel thrive in the surrounds, smashing 106 off the hapless Queanbeyan attack, not even a torn hammy early on in his dig stopping the carnage. Mark "Junior Stiffler" Hall chipped in with 48 batting at no.8, with Wests finishing up with 242. Queanbeyan capitulated with just 98, Gerard King backing up his Round 9 performance with 3/14 and Jimmy Harrison bowling 14 accurate overs for 3/24.

Next up, we needed a miracle to make the one-day semis, but all our post match team prayer sessions finally paid off and make them we did, smashing ANU at North oval compiling 193 in our innings, 77 from myself and 42 from Hooters. Our bowlers dispensed with the ANU batting line up for only 63 – well shared around with Jimmy Harrison 3/5, Jack Scasaghini 2/23 and Aaron Coddington 2/4.

The next weekend, the elation of making the final was initially tempered on the first day of Round 12 with Norths opener Gordon McGurk being dropped by us seven times in one dig, leaving him to make 60 odd and guiding his side to 233 on Kaleen. Nick Death toiled long and hard with the ball and returned the decent figures of 4/65, Maggsy also chipping in with 3/50. After a long, and mainly unsuccessful day in the field, we had to back up the following morning in the one-day final against Norths at Majura.

What a game. We notched up 9/210 off our 50 overs with various contributors. Myself (38), Gerard King (34), but the most memorable was Andrew McDermott with 34 runs sculpted from rock over 35 overs. Little David Roberts also chipped in with 22 runs late in the piece batting at no.8. Norths then set about smashing our bowling and reached 4/168 off 40 overs, only requiring 43 runs off the final 10 overs with 6 wickets in hand, but proceeded to choke like Mama Cass on a ham sandwich collapsing to 9/208 requiring 3 runs with 1 wicket remaining and one over to go. Jack Scasaghini stepped up to the plate bowled two dot balls then was hit for 2 runs by their number 11. Scasa dotted up the next two balls leaving 1 required off the last ball of the match which the Norths batsman dutifully stroked high in the air to mid-off where the safe (and shaking) hands of Matty Wheatley took the catch to tie it all up. Jimmy Harrison 3/31 and Jack Scasaghini 3/42 took the majority of the wickets, but Aaron Coddington bowled the spell of the day with 0/24 off his 10 shutting down the Norths attack when it was needed most. Another highlight was the fielding with some great outfield catching by both Gerard King and Andrew McDermott. Yeah Baby!

Returning to round 12, Norths finished us off the following week in the 2-dayer with our side only mustering 76, off which John Rogers made 34. Round 13 saw a return to form with us making 324 against Tuggeranong again (surprise, surprise) at

Condor. Robbo awoke from the batting dead and put together a majestic 123 and a record 5th wicket partnership of 178 with Stephen Hinds who made 73. Backing it up with the ball, Tuggs were knocked over for 211 with Jimmy Harrison taking 5/42.

And so to the last round. All we needed to do to make the 2-day finals was not loose outright to Gininderra, but loose outright to them we did. Other than Aaron Coddington (23), we batted like gimps to be all out for 76 in the first dig. Ginninderra knocked up a quick 5/101 declared following which we made a more reasonable 225, with Wheaters putting together his dig of the year with 75 imperious runs. In a turnaround from our 1-day final result it was our turn to be dealt a loosing hand by divine intervention. Gininderra made the 201 required 9 wickets down. Close, but no cigar. Jimmy Harrison again bowled well for 5/45.

Where did we go wrong in the 2-day comp? Our bowlers on the whole put in some steady performances and Hindsy was solid behind the stumps, however our batting results were a disappointment with no batsman making over 300 runs and only two making more than 200 for the season. What was needed was more application and consistency from our top order and some pressure from the lower grades to make the upper grade bats hungrier to retain their spots.

All in all, a mixed season, but not one without success. The 1-day final result is to be savored, even though it was a tie, as we never looked like being a chance until the last 6 balls bowled. We all clicked on the day and had 2nd grade cricketers putting in 1st grade performances to achieve the result we did. Great stuff.

Other more frivolous memories of the season included:

- Andrew Appledorfs stoush with Robbo in the run chase, seeing the regular number 11 outscoring Robbo (the self acclaimed "one-man top order strike force") for ½ the season at a rate of 2 to 1, only to see Apples campaign destroyed when he broke his arm riding his unicycle at the gay & lesbian Mardi-gras up George Street, Sydney.
- The spin twins partnership of Robert Maggs and Nick Jansen captivating all and sundry as they alternately sledged and praised each other throughout the year. Leg spinners are a truly strange breed. - Wheaters achievement to play an entire season, attend every post-match and other official function and not once dip into his own pockets to buy himself, or anyone else for that matter, a single beer.

WESTERN DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED 4TH GRADE CAPTAIN'S REPORT ONE DAY PREMIERS TWO DAY FINALISTS 2003 – 2004

How does one try to summarise within 4 or 5 paragraphs a season of memorable victories, forgettable losses and the more than occasional good laugh? To be honest, I'm not really sure, but here is my attempt anyway.

Having made the decision at the end of last summer not to play cricket this season I was a little hesitant to accept the role of 4th Grade skipper when it was offered to me in early November. I suppose it proved that being away from the game I love so much was going to be a lot harder than I thought. Having represented Western District Cricket Club in the higher grades over the last few seasons I seriously contemplated giving the game of cricket away due to a number of niggling injuries and the larger time commitments required to train and play in the top grades. However, having seen how other lower grade sides have benefited from having a senior cricketer within their ranks, I felt I owed something to a cricket club which had given me so much over the years.

Having accepted the offer to captain "Feisty Fours" I am pleased to be able to say it was one of the most memorable cricket seasons I can remember. Sure we won a one-day premiership and came painfully close to winning the two-day title, but what I came to realise from playing this season is that there is far more to cricket then just winning matches. That being said, it isn't all about playing "hit and giggle" cricket either. I found cricket in 4th grade to be about playing as well as you can with the cricketing ability you posses. It isn't about who hits the ball the furthest, or bowls the ball the quickest, but rather doing your best for the team and the club whilst still having a laugh at yourself (and more then occasionally each other).

At this time of year, as we all look back with perfect hindsight, it is worrying when you try to acknowledge individuals as you inevitably forget someone. So, if I happen to have omitted you from this report then feel free to pull my aside at the club one night and I will (subject to me believing that the performance was actually worthy of inclusion) buy you a beer (or probably a coke given the age of most of the guys I played with this year).

As for on-field highlights, the season began with Mark Ennis (Mennis) captaining the team to a dramatic loss in the opening game of the season against the ANU. As it turned out it was the start of many close matches against ANU last summer. For those of you (and there are many) who knew Mennis I am sure you would agree that he drinks like a native of Croydon (in South London) and, unfortunately, he captains like one also.

More notable performances included a 161 run 4th wicket partnership between Alan Copeland and Jhie Gough against Weston Creek. Clinton (Prunster) Lillepruun's efforts under the helmet at very short leg are also worth noting this year. Clarky's running between the wickets was a real highlight of both digs. His ability to turn a comfortable three into a quick single certainly brought more than an odd chuckle from the peanut gallery watching. However, both innings displayed Jeff's ability to concentrate for long periods and to play to his strengths. I know many of the young cricketers who watched those innings gained a great understanding of how the ability to occupy the crease for long periods through intense concentration is the key to scoring runs consistently at any level of cricket.

Steve Field (Lefty) was another who led our charge with the bat this summer. Lefty was a new addition to the club this season and a real pleasure to play with. He plays the game hard, but fair, and channels his on-field aggression which makes him a valuable player to captain as he had the ability to turn a game by making something out of nothing. Over the season, Fieldy was memorable for his inspirational spells with both bat and ball and was never short of a word, be it on the ground, or in the change rooms.

Andrew Greaves (Iceman) also showed his ice cool nerves by leading us to victory in both semi final appearances this year. I threw the ball to Greavesy when ANU required only 5 runs to win with one over remaining. Andrew bowled a magnificent over to concede only two runs off the bat (and 2 leg byes) to force a tie which guaranteed our place in the one day final. Having now lead us to victory with the ball, Greavesy then conjured up a victory for us in the 2-day semi final, once again against ANU. Needing 20 runs to win and only 1 wicket left, Greavesy partnered Theiva Surendera (Disco) to score 23 runs and send us into the two-day grand final. Greavesy's summer not only included winning two important matches for us, but also chipping his front tooth in half when trying to dance on off spin bowler at Forestry Oval and regularly providing an excellent impersonation a homeless person and/or a member of the Jon Butler Trio.

I think the most pleasing aspect of captaining 4's this year was the number of young cricketers I had the pleasure of taking the field with. Tad Lamb, Tom (Eddie Maguire) Colebatch, Will Witheridge, Mathew Chamberlain, Shane Bartle, Nick Brady and Shobang Mehta all made their way through 4's at some point this year. Each of these youngsters have the right approach to the game and I know they will play a prominent role in the higher grades over coming seasons. In particular, both Tad Lamb and Tom Colebatch played the majority of the season in 4's and made a real contribution to the side. Tad's batting improved significantly throughout the season, and as his confidence and strength grew, he played several important innings for our side on difficult wickets with frustratingly slow outfields. Patience and concentration are difficult things to coach a young cricketer. Tad has both of these and I know they will serve him well over his cricketing career. Also, Big Tommy Colebatch and Nick (Marsha) Brady spearheaded our new ball attack at different times this season and both bowled with plenty of pace and aggression throughout the summer. I won't be surprised to see them with the new ball in first grade over the next couple of seasons.

On a personal note, I am privileged to be able to say that I finally got to enjoy a season with a bunch of blokes who obviously hold a great passion for Westies and

the game of cricket. Getting the opportunity to play with a number of good mates who, until this season, I had only been able to watch from the sideline (or exchange cricketing stories with over a schooner of orange juice) was also a real delight.

Finally, sincere thanks to Jonny Fuller (previous 4's skipper) for his guidance throughout the year. His assistance in helping me understand the intricacies and oddities of 4th grade cricket were most appreciated. Also thanks to Fieldy for taking the reigns as captain when required and to Jeff for his help with team selections and the occasional field placement or two.

The 2003-04 cricket season was a consolidation year for the juniors both on and off the field. Although none of our teams made it to the final, three finished in third spot in their respective age groups. Two of those teams missed the final after tying for second place but being relegated to third on a count back. Our under 10 Gold team, however, completed the season undefeated.

As in other years our parent involvement grew momentum and together with the Senior Club we reinforced our joint program of providing assistance to the development of players and their transition into the grade ranks of WDCC.

Our numbers of players was down this year on previous years due mainly to the introduction of primary classes at nearby private schools and the desire of many of our more senior players to play in the Grade competition. In the non-competitive levels we fielded at least two teams in each age group and coaches and managers reported good levels of player and parent participation. A number of coaches and managers continued their roles from last season and their dedication and enthusiasm is appreciated.

The ACTJCA again chose representative sides in the under 13 to under 16 age groups and we had a number of players in the different age groups selected to represent the ACT. Indeed, Emma Rogers, from the Under 16 Junior Girls side, was chosen as the ACT female junior player of the year. Congratulations Emma

Our Have-A-Go players and their parents enthusiastically participated in the development of the skills so necessary for later age groups. A special thank you goes to the coordinator of the program, David Hohnke as well as to his chief helpers for making the sessions so helpful whilst creating a good time for all.

Our club has sponsors who provide player awards and perpetual trophies. On behalf of the club I thank Western District Rugby Club, Bob Lowe from Lowe's Plumbing, McDonalds Charnwood and Capital Trophies and Sportswear, Mitchell.

Finally, I acknowledge the hard work of the Executive Committee, General Committee, Age Group coordinators, Coaches and Managers. Without these people our club could not operate as successfully as it has. Especially notable has been the work of Andrew Jones and Ben Keens who provided their time to assist our under 15 team learn the skills required to succeed at Grade level.

WESTERN DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED HONORARY TREASURER'S REPORT AND FINANCIAL STATEMENTS (FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2004)

Season 2003/2004 saw the Club presented with potential financial problems from its commencement. Escalating operating costs combined with the responsibility for three grounds ensured our efforts in fundraising and managing our money cautiously this year were of the utmost importance. In light of these factors it is satisfying to present the audited financial statements for the year ended 30 April 2004 which disclose an annual operating surplus of \$6,181. Whilst this result looks favourable on paper it should be understood that aged liabilities of \$5,200 had been written off at year's end, without which our surplus would be a more modest \$981. Notwithstanding this the result is still a very good one for the Club.

Grant Funding

As can be seen at note 6 accompanying the financial statements, our grant income comprised funds sourced through the Western District Rugby Union Club (WDRUC) and the ACT Cricket Association (ACTCA) with a 69/31 per cent split respectively. This year in addition to the base \$9,000 granted by the WDRUC, the Committee managed to increase this amount by \$2,000 through negotiations with the Board of the WDRUC. As well as this the Club can expect to receive benefits through the WDRUC by essentially receiving GST credits on our major purchases. Early next financial year this scheme will save the Club \$1,070 which is the GST payable on our Trade Creditors liability.

Securing these funds from the WDRUC is subject to the satisfaction of the Affiliated Clubs Criteria and is subject to our increased patronage of the Licensed Club. It is in this regard that I urge members to return the generosity of the WDRUC by supporting them as much as they can.

This year the Club secured a \$5,000 coaching and development grant from the ACTCA enabling us to retain the services of our senior coach and support staff. The \$2,000 increase was due to our ability to demonstrate to the ACTCA that our Club has a sound management and coaching structure.

The management committee would like to sincerely thank the WDRUC and ACTCA for their support.

Subscriptions

For the fourth successive year, subscription fees stayed constant at the following rates:

Total subscriptions this year reached \$16,600 slightly surpassing our budgeted figure. As can be seen at note 2, \$2,070 (12%) of this was outstanding at 30 April. The collection of subscriptions over the last few years has not been an enviable task and has been exceedingly protracted with some members. I advocate those members to be more forthcoming with their payment in the future. Thankyou to Derek Gould and Jeff Clark for their support with the collection of subscriptions.


Other Income

Interest was down on last year given the lower cash stock held following the purchase of the Jamison Oval equipment. This year the committee decided to have each grade undertake a raffle to overcome our financial problems. After two of the raffles we had recorded two losses due to poor ticket sales by the respective grades and the project was dumped. The raffle we ran at the Prime Ministers XI match at Manuka pulled us from this hole and ensured that our raffle efforts eventuated with profit. Again the burden of the fund raising efforts fell on a select few. I strongly urge members who have not offered their assistance to the Club to get involved.

The other income we recorded of \$6,310 comprises a subsidy from the ACTCA for our participation in the NRMA Cup together with the above mentioned liability write-off.

Expenditure

A graph depicting comparative expenditure follows:

As is evident from the graph, salient items included:

- Ground Hire of \$6,198, which was slightly down on last year;
- Ball Purchases of \$5,403 which was well up on last year and attributable to many of the Clubs ball stock going missing;
- Umpire Fees were up by 58% this year to \$5,336 and is due to the fact that third grade saw more umpires this year and umpire fees increased;
- Coaching and Training costs were up on last year by \$1,642 because of the increased funding furnished by the ACTCA; and
- A depreciation write-off of \$2,018 was booked this year pertaining to the capital acquisitions of season 2002/2003.

This year the Club basically broke even on a cash basis. Next year will be an interesting one for the Club given the current negotiations with the University of

Canberra. A solid financial performance can be achieved with the recruitment of human resources within the Club. In this regard I encourage everyone to make themselves available for the sharing of administrative duties for the Club.

I would like to thank the Committee members for their hard work over the course of the year and their patience with my time restrictions. As this is my final year as Treasurer I would like to thank the Club for the opportunity to serve it. I have had an enjoyable three years as Treasurer and look forward to returning my services in the future.
