Note 1: Statement of significant Accounting Policies

(a) Basis of preparation

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (1991) of the ACT. The Committee has determined that the Association is not a reporting entity.

As the Association is a not for profit organisation whose turnover is below the required threshold, GST registration is not required. In these circumstances the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of any assets or included in the cost of expenses.

Revenue is measured a the fair value of the consideration or contributions received or receivable. Where revenue is received in the form of cash, the fair value of the consideration is the amount received.

After a long and distinguished involvement with ACTCA, Wests was the immediate beneficiary of the experience of a cricket tragic.

The following season, Derek was nominated for and assumed the role of Club President, a role he maintained from that time, right up until his passing on Christmas Day.

An organised and disciplined man, Derek was a perfect fit for a club desperately requiring attention. Derek was able to direct the club forward, committing whole heartedly to the running of the club, and was able to stabilise the financial position of the club.

Derek oversaw the ongoing operations of the club, and committed to several sub committees within ACTCA as the representative of our small organisation. Derek maintained his involvement with the Umpires council, as a standing umpire, committee member and umpire trainer, enormous commitments themselves, but a true reflection on his commitment to one of his greatest passions, cricket.

A man so dedicated to cricket can only do so by having strength of family behind him. Tedious and boring for those outside the playing and committee members, Ann was a constant at our club functions, showing support for the man she loved, and he loved his best friend, even more for that. My many discussions with Derek over the years included several conversations about the understanding and support of not only Ann, but his children and grandchildren. He spoke with so much pride of his children and their new families, the spark in his eye brightening as he described looking after and playing with the grand kids.

Derek was selfless, and interested in others, he always checked to see how the members of the club were going in their own lives. Especially important to me was the support he gave to me and my father through tough personal times. He acknowledged the efforts of others above his own and will always stay in my mind as a thoughtful and generous man.

Derek enjoyed a good yarn, and he had plenty of stories to tell from a lifetime of cricket. He was a link to the past, and could not only recount matches, but conversations and incidents from within these matches, providing a link to the past and an insight into a different era. For more than fifty years Derek committed himself to the game he loved, all over the world, and was duly awarded recognition from several organisations appreciating his involvement. He was proud of what he achieved through cricket, and proud of the recognition that came as a result. In recent years, he was honoured by none other than the International Cricket Council, crickets governing international body, for his services to cricket, one of his proudest achievements.

Derek was also the serving president for the last first grade premiership for Wests, and was proud of the clubs achievement in winning this title. The workload Derek assumed to enable us to play the game we love should never be understated. We owe a debt of gratitude to Derek and his family, men of such commitment are few and far between. In my time at Wests, no other individual has contributed more time and effort to the club that we love than Derek Reginald George Gould.

Most importantly for the club members, and myself, Derek was a friend and we will all miss him enormously. To Ann, David and Sarah, and your extended families, the sincerest thoughts are with you at this time, we will miss him, he will be part of our club and memories forever. Rest in Peace Derek and may your memory live in cricket forever mate.
